EMPOWERING GIRLS' VOICES: NCGS MIDDLE SCHOOL GLOBAL CITIZENSHIP

PROGRAM OVERVIEW







Starting September 2021, Close Up and the National Coalition of Girls' Schools will offer Empowering Girls' Voices: Civic Ambassadors Program. This is a special opportunity to nominate six 8th grade students (ages 13-14) to represent your school in an examination of today's most pressing issues with other girls from across the world. Over 1,000 students from more than 65 girls' schools participated in Empowering Girls' Voices. Past civic ambassadors' actions have included facilitating issue-centered deliberations for lower grades, starting a student ambassador advisory board, and creating "lunch box talks" to allow space for difficult dialogues.

Through this series of six online civic engagement workshops, students will build relationships, connect their experiences and personal stories to ongoing political debates and policy deliberations, and return back home to share what they have learned as civic ambassadors of their school communities.
