Never has there been a more important time for young women and girls to understand the challenges facing our democracy, engage with diverse perspectives, and make their voices heard. This year, in celebration of the 100th anniversary of the ratification of the 19th Amendment, [Close Up](#) and the [Institute for Social Impact](#) launched **Empowering Girls' Voices**—a program that brings together diverse students nationwide to inspire and empower the next generation of women leaders to lead, inspire, and break glass ceilings.

By engaging young women from communities nationwide in meaningful dialogue, we aim to help students develop empathy for the perspectives of others and build the skills and confidence needed to empower a generation of change-makers.

SURVEY DATA

Surveys of high school students who participated on recent Close Up programs revealed dramatic increases in the students' civic knowledge and attitudes.

- Pre-program 54% of students understood how laws are made; post-program results showed 97% of students understanding the law-making process.
- Pre-program, 31% of students felt comfortable discussing their ideas about government with others; post program, 87% of students replied in the affirmative.
- 95% of girls said program helped them feel empowered to use their voice to make change.
- 99% of girls said they would recommend this program to a friend.
- 100% of girls said the program helped them better understand issues facing our country.
