

EMPOWER YOUTH VOICES: DELIBERATIVE DEMOCRACY

Program Overview



Starting October 2021, Close Up and the Malone Schools Online Network will offer Series 1 of *Empower Youth Voices: Deliberative Democracy Program*. This is a special opportunity to nominate six students to represent your school. Through a series of six online workshops facilitated by Close Up, students from across Malone Schools will develop a deeper understanding of complex policy challenges facing the nation, connect those issues to long-standing values and tensions, and gain a rich understanding of the value of deliberation in a democracy.

Students will examine three major policy issues, evaluate proposals that represent a range of viewpoints, and consider, as a group, how to best address these issues. After deliberating, and developing a better understanding of their own values and priorities, students will participate in a training to develop the facilitation skills to lead controversial issue discussions with peers and in their own school communities.

Session Dates & Times

Series 1: Deliberative Democracy | Tuesdays & Thursdays after school | October 26 - November 9, 2021 | 8:00-9:15pm (EST) / 5:00-6:15pm (PST)
On Tuesday, December 14, 2021, a final reflection and debrief will take place following student facilitated discussions at their schools.
