Governor Ducey

Governor Doug Ducey was elected as Arizona's 23rd governor in 2014 and re-elected in 2018 with more votes than anyone in state history. Upon election, Arizona had a \$1 billion deficit and a sluggish economy. Today, Arizona has a record surplus, a balanced budget and a booming economy.

Michael Bidwill

Mr. Bidwill has served as team president since 2007 and became owner of the Arizona Cardinals in 2019. Since taking over as team president, his leadership has transformed the Cardinals both on and off the field. Of the franchise's seven all-time postseason wins, five have come with Michael leading the organization.
