

# CIVIL DISCOURSE CREDENTIAL DEVELOPING & MEASURING DURABLE SKILLS







Based on our 50+ years of experience in working with young people from all backgrounds, the credential guides high school students through exercises, activities, and experiences to develop highly needed durable skills such as <u>critical thinking</u>, <u>communication</u>, <u>media and Al literacy</u>, and <u>the ability to productively engage with multiple perspectives</u>.

# **CIVIL DISCOURSE CREDENTIAL OVERVIEW**

The Civil Discourse Credential focuses on competencies in three domains: (1) Analyzing Political and Social Issues; (2) Communicating Across Difference; and (3) Digital Citizenship and Media Literacy. Close Up provides criteria, activities, and resources to help students demonstrate their proficiency in each domain, all tracked through a Learning Record hosted by Mastery Transcript Consortium. Students might analyze the use of political rhetoric by elected officials, design resources with a multipartisan perspective on a politically complex topic, or facilitate a structured deliberation with peers to address a community issue.



Three stackable credentials that demonstrate competency in all aspects of civil discourse, including critical thinking, communication, collaboration, and the ability to productively engage with multiple perspectives.

Earn a credential in one or two domains, or complete all three to receive the comprehensive Civil Discourse Credential!




For achieving proficiency in a domain, students earn a stackable credential for their transcript and resume. For mastering all three, they earn the comprehensive Civil Discourse Credential.

# **CIVIL DISCOURSE CREDENTIAL PILOT PROGRAM**

To begin classroom implementation, Close Up launched the Civil Discourse Credential Pilot Program in 2025. Pilot educators participated in a two-day training institute to gain an understanding of, model, and practice the credential lessons and activities. Throughout the school year, they will attend monthly coaching sessions and provide feedback to help Close Up refine the credential and prepare for nationwide scaling. Thus far, the pilot cohort includes educators from **30 public, charter, and independent schools across 17 states**. In the first year of the pilot program, we anticipate reaching **over 1,000 students** nationwide.
